- Black provides rarely-before-seen FBI transcripts of taped phone conversations that prove he was not involved in the money laundering and fraud schemes perpetrated by "Cash 4 Titles," a company he had been investing both his and his clients' money with;
- A lifelong philanthropist, Black has pledged part of the proceeds from this book to charities;
